While some congregation reserve funds are available for this project, almost certainly a special appeal campaign will be needed. As soon as more information becomes available, it will be published and then explained at the special congregational meeting.

Gift cards to Giant, Redner's, or Weis to support fresh produce, meat, and dairy items



participating in the concert!




