Excentia Preschool Forced to Refocus Its Mission

For over thirty years, beginning with the S. June Smith Preschool, which later became Excentia, the cheerful sounds of children's voices have been a joyful part of daily life at Holy Trinity. This has been a cherished aspect of our community, reminding us of the importance of supporting one another by sharing the space that God has provided to improve the lives

of families in meaningful, life-changing ways.

Unfortunately, ongoing government cuts to funding for vital educational programs, such as the one here at Holy Trinity, which provides essential one-on-one assistance to children with special needs in a supportive classroom setting, have compelled the preschool to reevaluate its operations. Beginning in the fall of this year, the preschool will shift its focus to offer educational services specifically for children with autism. This transition is already underway at Excentia's Lancaster location, underscoring the need for additional space for these vital services. The school will continue to operate five days a week from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM. We will see a change in the educational staff, with those presently teaching at Holy Trinity being offered positions elsewhere as part of other Excentia programs.

During this time of transition and unexpected change, please keep all staff members and those guiding this change in your thoughts and prayers.

MOYER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The John H. Moyer and Erma R. Moyer Scholarship Trust of The Evangelical Lutheran Church of the Holy Trinity has been established through a gift by their son, John R. Moyer, to honor his parents and perpetuate the family's belief in the importance of higher education.

The Trust provides for a one-year scholarship of \$1,000.00 to be awarded annually to an active member of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church. As the investment grows, the Finance Committee can recommend to the Congregational Council increasing the amount. The Finance Committee will notify the Congregation Council in June each year of the amount available to be awarded so the Council can determine the number of scholarships that can be offered.

Applications and detailed Scholarship selection information can be obtained from the Church office. Completed applications and transcripts must be returned to the Church office no later than July 15. Congregation Council will approve all applicable scholarship applications. Scholarship checks will be produced and presented to each approved applicant in September.
